1. This petition was filed for issuance of directions to the official respondents for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners from the private respondents No. 4 to 8 arrayed in the petition.

2. As per the pleadings the petitioners had performed marriage against the wishes of their parents and there was a threat perception.

3. On 24th November, 2021, the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

Mr. V. G. Jauhar, Senior DAG, Punjab appearing on advance notice accepts the same and seeks time to have instructions.

Put up on 6.12.2021.

In the meantime, the police officials not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police should record the statements of the petitioners.

In case a request is made by the petitioners, they may be provided shelter in safe house till the next date.”

Learned State counsel has filed reply and pleading that

statement of the petitioners were recorded and they have stated that there is no threat perception.

5. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that no cause of action surviving for pursuing the present petition.

6. Disposed of as infructuous.
