SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners and respondents No.4 and 5 are residing in the same street at village and post office Khan Kot, Tehsil Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar. The front side of house of respondents No.4 and 5 is up from the house of the petitioner No.1 due to soil and in rainy days, rain water comes in the petitioner's house, about which the petitioner No.1 informed the Sarpanch, who told him to equalize the soil level to get rid of the said problem. On 30.10.2021, when the petitioner No.1 and his son started the work of equalizing at the front of their house, respondents No.4 and 5 came out and started beating them. After hearing noise, petitioner No.2, who lives in the same street, came out in support of petitioner No.1 but the respondents No.4 and 5 gave slap on her face, tore her clothes and started using abusive language for her.

As a result thereof, petitioner No.1 moved a representation (Annexure P-2) to S.H.O. Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar but till date, no action has been taken on the same.

Now, the prayer on behalf of the petitioners is that a direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tanvir Joshi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the representation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2–Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural) to decide the representation (Annexure P-2) within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representation to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural) for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
