The application in CM-10556-CII-2020 is ordered and the hearing of the main appeal is advanced to today.

The claimants in MACT Case No.22 of 2014 on the file of the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Karnal, filed the main appeal under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, seeking enhancement of the compensation awarded to them, *vide* Award dated 01.08.2015, in relation to the death of their son.

While so, the application in CM-10556-CII-2020 was filed by the Future General India Insurance Company, the third respondent, seeking

disposal of the appeal as per the compromise arrived at by it with the appellants. In terms thereof, the Insurance Company offered a further sum of ₹ 30,000/- in full and final settlement of the appellants' claim for enhanced compensation.

Mr. Rajiv Kumar Saini, learned counsel for the appellants, would state that his clients are willing to accept the offered amount and waive their right, if any, to seek further enhancement.

In the light of the settlement arrived at by and between the parties and the statements made in support thereof by both the learned counsel, the appeal is disposed of directing the third respondent-Insurance Company to pay a further sum of ₹ 30,000/-, by way of cheque, within four weeks. The cheque shall be made out in the name of the second appellant and shall be delivered to her under due and proper acknowledgment.

No order as to costs.
