Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners are undertaking the construction of their house, which is being objected by respondents No.5 to 7 and on one occasion, while the petitioners were continuing with the construction, they were threatened by respondents No.5 to 7, which act of theirs has given an impression that there is a threat to life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the said apprehension has already been brought to the notice of the police authorities vide representations dated 14.08.2021 and 17.11.2021, which have been appended with the present petition as Annexures P/1 and P/2 respectively and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab who is present in the Court accpets notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representations dated 14.08.2021 and 17.11.2021 (Annexures P/1 and P/2) submitted by the petitioners in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in representations dated 14.08.2021 and 17.11.2021 (Annexures P/1 and P/2), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the said representations submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. It will be appreciated if before deciding the said representations, all the parties, who are likely to be effected by the same are heard.

The present petition stands disposed of.
