The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 72 dated 23.09.2021, under Sections 379, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner and other accused had damaged the car and other articles belonging to the complainant. He also contends that the matter has been compromised. A copy of the compromise is at Annexure P3.

This Court, by the order dated 24.11.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel contends that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 24.11.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
