The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to respondent No.2 to take into consideration the representation submitted by the petitioner on 09.03.2021 by registered post and to take an action in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that for her grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation (Annexure P-4) to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana i.e. respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. A.S.Gill, Senior DAG, Punjab, has put in appearance through the medium of video conferencing and accepts notice on behalf of official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to take a decision on the representation (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
