4. This fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel on instructions received from SI Balkaran Singh. However, learned State counsel has opposed the bail. conditions

5. Given the nature of allegations, no pre-trial incarceration is required. Without commenting on the case's merits and the circumstances peculiar to this case, the petitioner makes a case for release on bail.

6. Given above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 25.11.2021 is hereby made absolute.
