The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking protection to his life and liberty at the hands of the respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that respondent No.5 alongwith some other persons trespassed the office of the petitioner on 25.10.2021 and looted Rs.15,000/- in cash. It is further submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the police was called on help line number but, due to the influence of respondent No.5, the police did not take any action qua the said incident, after which, the petitioner approached the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana by way of filing a representation dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P/1), which is still pending consideration with the said authority and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to said authority to decide the representation

dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P/1).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, DAG, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and states that the representation dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P/1) submitted by the petitioner to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, will be decided in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in a representation dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P/1), Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to decide representation dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P/1) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
