Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner though, evaded law by violating the terms and conditions of his bail order and went abroad but keeping in view the financial status, in which the petitioner was at the relevant given point of time, he adopted the said method to make his career, though he should not have violated the terms and conditions of his bail order. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is of violating the Excise Act and the co-accused, who cooperated with the trial, though was found guilty, but was released on probation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the act, which the petitioner has committed, has resulted that he has been unable to meet

his old parents, who are suffering various medical problems. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court within a period of six weeks and the prayer of the petitioner is that bail petition, which he might file after he surrenders, may kindly be decided expeditiously preferably within 2-3 days.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and applies for the grant of regular bail, the same may be disposed of by passing an appropriate order within a period of 3 working days of filing of the said application.
