SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is aggrieved because order of mutation of shamlat land in its favour has been partially stayed by the Deputy Commissioner. The said order is admittedly under challenge before the learned Divisional Commissioner, Rupnagar (respondent No.2). Meanwhile, the private respondents had approached the Financial Commissioner who has disposed of the matter with a direction to them to approach the Divisional Commissioner and press their claim before him. Till then, the order passed by the Deputy Commissioner adverse to their interests has been stayed.

It is submitted that stay granted by the learned Financial Commissioner is adversely affecting the interests of the residents of Naya Gaon. Thus, respondent No.2 be directed to expedite the hearing of the stay application.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 & 2 only.

Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed there is no necessity to seek a reply from the respondents.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take up the stay application on the next date of hearing i.e. 30.11.2021 and to decide the same after hearing both the parties on the same date.
