SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. In FIR No. 46 of 02.05.2021, registered at Police Station Mattewal, District Amritsar, offences constituted under Sections 326, 324, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860, are embodied.

2. Through an order made on 29.11.2021, this Court had granted *ad-interim* bail to the petitioner, however, subject to his ensuring recovery to the investigating officer concerned, of the incriminatory weapon of offences.

3. Today, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, appearing on behalf of State of Punjab, on instructions meted to him by ASI Harbans Singh, fairly submits, that the bail petitioner has ensured recovery, at his instance, to the investigating officer, of the incriminatory weapon of offences. Therefore, since the petitioner, has rendered the utmost co-operation to the investigating officer, in the investigations conducted by him, in the offences carried in FIR (supra).

4. Consequently, this Court deems it fit to make absolute the order made by this Court, on 29.11.2021, however, subject to the bail petitioner

rendering co-operation to the investigating officer concerned, as and when he is summoned through a written hukamnama, issued upon him, by the investigating officer concerned.
