The dispute between the petitioner and respondents no.4 to 23, is with respect to apportionment of compensation, payable for acquisition of the land. As per Section 30 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, the dispute with regard to apportionment is required to be decided by the reference court. There is corresponding provision under Section 76 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013. The petitioner claims to be a co-sharer in the joint land. It is alleged that partition proceedings are pending. The petitioner has statutory efficacious alternative remedy, therefore, the petitioner is relegated to the alternative remedy.
