Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action on the representation dated 22.09.2021, which has been submitted against private respondents No.4 to 8.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the daughter of the petitioner was married to respondent No.4 on 23.04.2021 and sufficient dowry in cash as well as in kind was given to the private respondents on their demand. He submits that the petitioner came to know that respondent No.4 was already married and this fact had not been disclosed to the petitioner as well as his family. On 21.08.2021, respondent No.4 left petitioner's daughter at her paternal home and did not take her back despite the fact that efforts were made through a Panchayat to rehabilitate her. He submits that the private respondents have committed a fraud with the

petitioner, have been extending threats to them and representations, Annexures P-1 and P-2, in this connection have been submitted to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, respondent No.2, which have not yielded any result. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official-respondent to look into the representation, Annexure P-1.

Request of counsel has been considered.

Without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representations submitted by the petitioner, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 22.09.2021, Annexure P-1, and to take suitable steps thereon as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the order along with the representation, Annexure P-1, be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur-respondent No.2 to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
