The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 442 dated 01.09.2019 under Sections 323, 325, 341, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Sector-9A, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between husband and wife, no weapon is alleged to have been used and the petitioner is alleged to have punched his wife. He also contends that the matter had been sent to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court but the complainant did not appear before the Mediator.

This Court, by order dated 19.12.2019 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Barjinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 19.12.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
