The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to release entire retiral benefits to the petitioner including Provident Fund, Leave Encashment, Gratuity, Arrears of Increments, Arrears of Special Increment on completion of 32 years of service and Arrears of revised pay and other due retiral benefits with interest @ 12% p.a. as well as to decide the legal notice dated 26.09.2021 (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Sudeepti Sharma, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 26.09.2021 (Annexure P-1), as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
