The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.35 dated 15.07.2019 under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Women District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the FIR in question was got registered on account of matrimonial dispute between the parties. He further submits that false allegations were levelled by the complainant against the petitioner with respect to the harassment meted out to her on account of dowry demand. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 19.02.2020, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Tasvir Singh states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 19.02.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
