The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for quashing the order dated 09.10.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.4 after the objections being raised by respondent No.4 vide which an amount to Rs.1,52,580/- has been recovered from the gratuity of the petitioner from the gratuity pay order after his retirement on 31.07.2019 from the post of Lineman as all the retiral benefits has been paid to the petitioner, pension has been sanctioned but the recovery has been made effective from gratuity, in a wrong, illegal and arbitrary manner.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representation dated 22.10.2019/14.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
