Consequently, nothing survives in the present petition and is disposed of as having been withdrawn with liberty to learned counsel for the petitioners to file fresh in case any threat perception arises. The interim protection order dated 25.11.2021, is hereby recalled. However, it shall be open for the petitioners to approach this Court again in case of any threat perception. It is made clear that withdrawal of the present petition will not come in the way of filing of fresh petition, if need arise.
