(Gratuity) and leave encashment in view of the rule 2.2 (c) read with explanation to rule 2.2 (c) read with explanation to rule 2.2 (b) of Punjab Civil Services Rules Volume-II and instructions of Department of Personnel and Administrative reforms dated 04.08.1982 (P-6) and Punjab State Vigilance Instructions dated 06.03.2000 (P-7).
