Main case

Revision petition, *herein*, is for issuance of directions to the
Additional District and Sessions Judge-cum-Principal Family Court, U.T.
Chandigarh, to decide and adjudicate the application filed by the petitioner-
wife under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act on 08.05.2019 (Annexure
P-3) in the petition filed under Section 13(1)(A) of the Hindu Marriage Act,
bearing HMA No.449 of 2018 dated 29.05.2018 titled as 'Bhupesh Sharma
vs PriyaChibber', filed by the respondent-husband, seeking dissolution of
marriage.

2. Heard.

3. Ordinarily, this Court would have refrained to interfere merely
because the application filed by the petitioner-wife under Section 24 of the

Hindu Marriage Act, is pending. In view of the recent pandemic, the Courts have been working under restrictions and it is but natural that certain unavoidable delays would be caused beyond the control of the Courts below. However, since the petitioner is un-employed and has to essentially depend on the outcome of the said application seeking maintenance, which has been pending for more than two years, the instant petition is disposed of with the expectation from the Family Court that the application shall be taken up on the next date of hearing and no further unnecessary adjournment shall be granted at the request of either of the parties.
