Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to remove pay anomaly between senior and junior Art and Craft Teachers.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for petitioners, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case legal notice dated 25.10.2021 (P-2) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3-Director, Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice in

accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
