Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that despite respondent No. 5 being not eligible for allotment of work, his bid has been accepted by the official respondents ignoring the fact that the experience certificate/claim made by the said respondent is not supported by any documentary evidence and rather it is a forged claim with regard to one year period.

Petitioner has been approaching the respondents for redressal of his grievance and has even served a notice through counsel dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P-6) which has not yet been decided.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to The Punjab State Federation of Cooperative Sugar Mills Ltd., through its Managing

Director, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali and General Manager, the Budhewal Cooperative Sugar Mills Ltd., Budhewal, District Ludhiana, respondents No. 2 and 3 respectively, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P-6) served by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.
