Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to promote petitioner to the post of Restorer from the post of Process Server with all consequential benefits.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case representation dated 22.07.2021 (P-6) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Deputy Secretary (Revenue) Department of Revenue, Rehabilitation & Disaster Management, Chandigarh to consider and decide the

aforesaid representation in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
