Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this second petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.02 dated 06.01.2019 registered under Sections 302, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 29 and 30 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for petitioner seeks for grant of regular bail to the petitioner by stating that the petitioner has been in custody from the last three years and trial would likely take some time to conclude as out of 26 prosecution witnesses only 02 witnesses are examined till date.

Per contra, while opposing the grant of bail to the petitioner, learned State counsel submits that complainant namely Amarjit Kaur whose husband Karam Singh, was referred to DMC, Ludhiana, succumbed to the injuries during treatment because of fatal injuries attributed to the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

There are serious allegations against the petitioner. It is the case

where fatal injury has been attributed to the petitioner, who had given fire shot injury upon the deceased Karam Singh. Thus, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

Keeping in view the gravity of the offence, no case is made out for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
