The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to official respondents to initiate appropriate legal action against the private respondents No.5 and 6 and to decide the representation dated 20.09.2021 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner.

It is contended that respondents No.5 and 6 cheated the petitioner and duped him to the tune of Rs.2,60,000/- on the pretext of sending his son to abroad. Finding himself duped by respondents No.5 and 6, petitioner and his family tried to find out the said respondents but to no avail. Consequently, he submitted a representation dated 20.09.2021 to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran but till date, no action has been taken on the same.

The limited prayer on behalf of the petitioner is that a direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tanvir Joshi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the representation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3—Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to decide the representation dated 20.09.2021 (Annexure P-3) within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representation to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
