At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that before filing the present petition, the petitioner has not approached the higher authorities in the Investigating Agency so as to point out that the investigation in FIR No.479 dated 08.08.2021 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 379-B, 452 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Shivaji Colony, Rohtak is not being done in a free and fair manner, hence the petitioner be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the higher authorities in the Investigating Agency raising the said grievance at this stage.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, AAG, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, very fairly submits that in case any representation is filed, the same will be disposed of in accordance with law within a period of six weeks

by passing appropriate order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the petitioner be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the higher authorities in the Investigating Agency to raise the grievance, as raised in the present petition at this stage.
