Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case, the grievance of the petitioner is that despite the fact that he has brought to the notice of the police a cognizable offence, as he was defrauded, still, no action is being taken on the said complaint by the police. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised his grievance before the Additional Director General of Police by filing a representation dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P-1), which has already been sent to the Inspector General of Police, NIR Wing, Phase 7, SAS Nagar, Mohali for comments but no further action has been taken on the said complaint. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is

issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P-1) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State raises no objection in deciding the representation of the petitioner dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P-1) by respondent No.2 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P-1), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P-1) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
