The petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents to count daily wages/work charge service for the purpose of pensionary benefit/retrial benefits to the petitioners along with interest @ 24% per annum.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage the petitioners would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide legal notice dated 15.04.2021 (Annexure P-11), within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and has submitted that

the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioners.

In view of the above, respondents-State is directed to take a conscious decision upon legal notice dated 15.04.2021 (Annexure P-11) served by the petitioners, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that in case the petitioners are found entitled to the financial benefits on such conscious decision to be taken by the respondents-State, then the same shall be actually released to the petitioners within a further period of three months from the date of such decision.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
