Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.213 dated 10.09.2019 registered under Sections 323, 341, 452, 307, 379, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 30 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was granted the concession of anticipatory bail on 28.07.2020 by the trial Court and was attending the Court proceedings, however on 16.09.2021, the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court due to some unavoidable circumstances and his bail/surety bonds were cancelled. It is further submitted that the petitioner undertake to appear before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State and has not raised any serious objection to the submission made by counsel for the petitioner except that the petitioner has delayed the proceedings before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on or before 06.12.2021 and the trial Court will release the petitioner on interim bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds.

This will, however, be subject to payment of costs of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Hoshiarpur.
