(The case has been taken up in National Lok Adalat through video conferencing on account of Covid-19 Pandemic).

The matter has been amicably settled between the parties. As per the statements recorded, it has been settled that the Insurance Company-respondent No.2 shall pay a sum of Rs. 50,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

As per the settlement effected between the parties, respondent No.2-Insurance Company shall pay a sum of Rs. 50,000/- over and above the amount which has already been awarded by the learned MACT. The amount shall be deposited within a period of four weeks before the learned MACT failing which respondent No.2-Insurance Company shall be liable to pay the enhanced amount of compensation with interest @ 9% per annum from the date of settlement before the Lok Adalat i.e. today. The enhanced amount of compensation shall be apportioned equally among the claimants.

The share of minor appellant Nos.1 and 2 in the enhanced amount of compensation shall be deposited in a fixed deposit in a nationalized bank to be

payable to them at attaining the age of majority and no financial liability shall be permissible on the aforesaid FDRs.

Disposed of accordingly.

Copy of order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
