The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to register an FIR against the private respondents.

It is contended that the petitioners herein have been duped at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5, however, despite complaints/representations having been given, no action has been taken thereon.

At this stage, Mr. Parampreet Singh Paul, Addl. P.P., U.T., Chandigarh, who is present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. He, on instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh, would submit that the matter is being looked into and will be concluded expeditiously.

The instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to conclude the matter expeditiously, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
