The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the work-charge/daily wage service of the petitioner with effect from June 1986 to 06.06.2000 followed by regular service towards pensionary benefits viz. Pension, Gratuity, GP Fund and Leave Encashment etc. and to release him the aforesaid revised pensionary benefits after counting his daily wage/work-charge service followed by regular service with interest thereon @ 12% p.a. as well as to decide his legal notice dated 15.10.2021 (Annexure P4).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with

direction to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 15.10.2021 (Annexure P4) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
