The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to take a final decision on the notice of demand of justice dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P4) with a further direction to the respondents to grant notional promotion to the post of DSP from the date his juniors have been promoted.

Ms. Harsimrat Rai, Dy. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondent. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the notice of demand dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P4), as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
