The petitioners have invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to count their previous work-charge service as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary benefits in terms of instructions issued by respondent Board (Annexure P5) and judgment (Annexure P8), with a further direction to the respondents to revise the pension and pensionary benefits of the petitioners along with consequential benefits including arrears and interest @ 12% p.a. as well as to decide his legal notice dated 23.08.2021 (Annexure P7).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with

direction to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 23.08.2021 (Annexure P7) as representation of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioners without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
