The petitioner in this petition seeks issuance of a Writ in the nature of *Mandamus* directing the respondents to extend the facility of Credit Guarantee Scheme for Subordinate Debt (CGSSD) to the petitioner as mandated by Government of India.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had given a representation dt. 17.03.2021 to respondent No.3-the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana who is the Nodal Officer under the Scheme and that respondent No.3 had not passed any orders thereon.

Having regard to the aforesaid submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondent No.3 to consider the representation of the petitioner dt.17.03.2021 within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and inform the petitioner of the decision taken thereon.

It is made clear that we have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the contentions of petitioner.
