The petitioners have invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider them for promotion as Sub Inspector and further as Inspector in their own local rank with effect from the date when the DPC was constituted on 05.09.2019 with a further prayer to grant the petitioners revised pensionary benefits along with interest @ 9% p.a., as well as to decide their legal notice dated 12.10.2021 (Annexure P6).

Heard.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Harsimrat Rai, Dy. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 12.10.2021 (Annexure P6) as representation of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioners without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
