The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 178 dated 16.07.2019 under Sections 498-A and 406 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance with order dated 02.07.2021/30.09.2021, the petitioner has joined investigation. He has further submitted that the matter stands amicably settled between the petitioner and his wife i.e. the complainant and both of them are living together in the same house.

Learned State counsel on instructions, from ASI Amrik Singh, has not been able to controvert the factum of the matter having been amicably settled between the parties. He has apprised the Court that in the wake of the developments which have taken place subsequent to the registration of the FIR in question, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 02.07.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
