This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

By means of instant writ petition, the petitioners have approached this Court for seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents to not proceed with the action of dispossessing the petitioners from their place of business i.e. Hisar Mandi, during the pendency of the review petitions bearing Nos.44 to 48 and 50 of 2021 (Annexures P-7 to P-12) pending before the respondent No.2.

It was put to the learned counsel for the petitioners that the review petitions in question have been filed after a delay of 887 days in four matters whereas the delay in filing the review petitions are 2039 days and 1387 days in the other matters, without furnishing any satisfactory explanation. The review petitions having been filed only in

the month of November 2021, hence, it cannot be said that the authorities in question are delaying the proceedings.

Confronted with the above, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the aforesaid writ petition with liberty to pursue his remedies before the authorities in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
