This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to trial Court, Patiala to conclude the trial of case within three months, titled as State Vs. Harish Chander bearing No.720 of 2018, which was registered after filing of Challan on 26.12.2018 in FIR No.64 dated 24.08.2018, registered at Police Station Women, Patiala, Punjab under Sections 354, 354-A, 354-D, 506, 341 and 509 IPC, as respondent No.2 unnecessarily delaying the matter.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the prosecution has already examined seven witnesses and the cross-examination of complainant (petitioner) is yet to be concluded and the case is fixed before the trial Court for 05.01.2022.

Considering the stage of the trial and its pace as the trial Court had adjourned the case on 02.12.2021 for 05.01.2022 which shows that the trial is likely to conclude in the near future.

Resultantly, no case is made out for exercising the inherent

powers for issuance of directions as prayed for.
