In view of the oral agreed statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as learned counsel for the Insurance Company, both the parties have compromised for a sum of Rs.70,000/- (Rupees Seventy Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, to be paid to the appellant in full and final settlement of their claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque/draft in the sum of Rs.70,000/- (Rupees Seventy Thousand Only) favouring the appellants with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of 30 days from today. In case of non-compliance, the appellant shall be entitled to interest @ 9% per annum on their respective share from the date of order till the date of realisation. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the learned

counsel on record.

Appeal stands disposed of.
