Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for directing the respondent(s) to remove the anomaly between the pay of senior and junior Government employees which has arisen due to implementation of 4-years ACP in the pay scales re-revised in the year 2011 by stepping up the pay of senior Government employees and further to grant all arrears of pay and consequential benefits along with interest @ 12% per annum.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 19.08.2021 (P-9) is decided expeditiously.

2. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 19.08.2021 (P-9), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
