Prayer in this petition is for setting-aside the order dated 06.10.2021 passed by the trial Court in FIR No.96 dated 17.06.2019 registered under Sections 21/22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar (Rural), vide which the bail granted to the petitioner was cancelled and his bail/surety bonds were cancelled.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was granted the concession of regular bail by the trial Court and thereafter, he was appearing before the trial Court, however, on 06.10.2021, due to some unavoidable circumstances, the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court and his bail/surety bonds were cancelled and the trial Court has issued Non-bailable Warrants against him. Counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and apply for fresh bail.

Counsel for the State could not dispute the factual position. It is also not disputed that the recovery effected from the petitioner is of non-commercial quantity.

After hearing the counsel for the parties, considering the fact that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and apply for fresh bail, the present petition is allowed and the trial Court is directed to consider the bail application for the petitioner and grant him regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds subject to the condition that the petitioner will deposit the costs of Rs.10,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority, Amritsar, for delaying the proceedings before the trial Court.
