By this petition, the petitioner is challenging order dated 12.11.2021 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No. 6 and set aside notice/information dated 15.11.2021 (Annexure P-6) issued by respondent No.5-Deputy Commissioner, Hisar whereby final publication of wardbandi has been done illegally.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that notice/information was issued on 18.10.2021 (Annexure P-1) showing the Ward Bandi of Zilla Parishad for the upcoming general election of Panchayati Raj Institution. Against this notice/information, the petitioner has filed his objections on 26.10.2021 (Annexure P-2).

The main objection of the petitioner was that the village Sundawas was not merged in Ward No. 11 while village Shahpur was merged in Ward No. 11. As per order dated 26/27.10.2021 passed by Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Hisar (Annexure P-4), the petitioner was heard personally on 25.10.2021 and village Sundawas was merged in Ward No. 11 from Ward No. 10 and the village Shahpur was merged in Ward No. 13

from Ward No. 11. To this extent, the petitioner has no grievance.

The grievance of the petitioner now is that vide order dated 12.11.2021 (Annexure P-5), on an appeal filed by one Sh. Krishan Sarhana, village Shahpur was shifted from Ward No. 11 to Ward No. 10 and Gram Panchayat Gorchi was included in Ward No. 11.

Learned counsel for the State submits that order dated 12.11.2021 (Annexure P-5) does not affect the petitioner as the main objection of the petitioner was that village Sundawas was not merged in Ward No. 11 and vide order dated 26/27.10.2021 (Annexure P-4), village Sundawas was merged in Ward No. 11. Hence, the petitioner cannot challenge order dated 12.11.2021 (Annexure P-5). Further, the petitioner has not chosen to file any appeal against order dated 26/27.10.2021 (Annexure P-4). Hence, now the petitioner cannot object that village Shahpur be included in Ward No. 11.

Writ petition is dismissed.
