This is a petition seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 288 dated 15.11.2017, registered under Section 21 (b) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa (in case Number 44-2018 NDPS) during pendency of the trial.

Perusal of the records shows that earlier also, the petitioner had absented from the Court proceedings before the trial Court. He was granted concession of appearance before the trial Court by protecting him against his arrest, vide order dated 03.07.2019 passed by this Court in CRM M 27659 of 2019. Again, the petitioner has resorted to the same modality of absenting from Court and seeking anticipatory bail. Moreover, in the head note of the present petition, the petitioner has clearly mentioned '*first petition under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of concession of anticipatory bail*' whereas it is second petition. From the above, it appears that the petitioner is trying to play a trick upon this Court, as well. Hence, this Court does not find any ground to grant any kind of concession to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the present petition stands dismissed.
