This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, in case FIR No.239 dated 20.04.2021, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat, Haryana.

[2]. The petitioner by now has remained in detention for more than 4 ½ months following his arrest on 16.07.2021. After completion of investigation, challan against the petitioner has already been submitted. The trial is yet to commence.

[3] As such, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified.

[4]. For the aforesaid reasons, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, but in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail subject to appropriate terms

and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
