Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner being aggrieved of an order dated 01st June 2021 (Annexure P-1) declining his request to be released on parole.

Perusal of the impugned order passed by the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana would reveal that the petitioner had sought concession of parole to meet his family members and had given the address of an acquaintance/friend i.e., Gurmeet Singh S/o Mahinder Singh resident of House No.57, Block-B near Bhole Nath Mandir, Diary Complex, Haibowal Khurd, District Ludhiana.

Counsel during the course of hearing was put a specific query as to whether his family members are residing at the afore-noticed address.

Response is in the negative.

Under such circumstances, we do not find any infirmity in the order dated 01st June, 2021 (Annexure P-1) declining the concession of parole.

Petition as such is dismissed.

Liberty, however, is granted to the petitioner to apply afresh for parole by furnishing the necessary and correct address.

In the eventuality of any such application being made, the same would be considered by the competent authority in accordance with law.
