The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the daily wage as Special Police Officer (SPO) service of the petitioner, rendered before his respective regularization as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits as the same benefit has been granted by this Hon'ble court and same has been compliance by the respondent Department vide (Annexures P-9 and P-10) or in the alternative the respondents be directed to decide the representation dated 08.09.2021 (Annexure P-11) in the light of the mandate of this Hon'ble High Court.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Copy supplied.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representation dated 08.09.2021 (Annexure P-11) moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
