AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 11 dated 14.1.2021, under Sections 409, 420, 120-B and 201 IPC and Section 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at Police Station Murthal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order passed by this Court on 1.11.2021 in CRM-M-45599 of 2021 stating that similarly situated co-accused were granted interim anticipatory bail in the present FIR and the petitioner had already joined investigation and no recovery is to be made.

Learned counsel for the State appearing on advance notice on instructions from Inspector-Lehna Singh submits that the petitioner had joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the statement made, the present petition is disposed of. The petitioner is granted anticipatory bail subject to her joining investigation as and when called for. In the event of her arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to her furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. She shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

In case of failure of petitioner to join the investigation, the State would be at liberty to file an application for re-calling of this order.
