The present application has been filed for pre-ponement of the date of hearing in the main writ petition from 04.10.2021 to an early date on the ground that matter is covered by the decision rendered by this Court in the case of **Vikram Singh and others vs. State of Haryana and others**, CWP No.26206 of 2019, decided on 24.08.2021.

Keeping in view of the averments made in the application, which is supported by the affidavit of the applicant-petitioner, the same is hereby allowed and the date of hearing in the main writ petition is pre-poned to today from 04.10.2021 and the main case is taken on board for hearing.

CWP No.26206 of 2019

In the application, filed for pre-ponement of the date of hearing, it has been averred that the petitioner wants to participate in the ongoing transfer drive but on account of the stand, as such, of the respondents, he is not being permitted to participate in the transfer drive on account of the stay order having been passed in his favour on 17.09.2019.

However, this Court, in **Vikram Singh's case (supra)**, has held that the employees, who are willing to participate in the ongoing transfer drive, will be permitted by the State Government to participate in the transfer drive subject to the terms and conditions contained in the prevalent Teachers Transfer Policy, irrespective of the fact that they had challenged their earlier transfer orders and had got interim orders from this Court.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court in **Vikram Singh's case (supra)**.
