Present petition has been filed for protection of life and liberty of petitioners who are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that keeping in view the matrimonial dispute of the petitioners' son with his in-laws, the petitioners are also being involved, though, the petitioners have already disowned their son namely Nafees Ahmed Khan.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that fearing threat to their life and liberty, the petitioners have approached the police by filing a representation dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P-9) and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mewat to decide the said

representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, AAG, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioners by respondent No.3 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No.3 is directed to decide representation dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P-9) submitted by the petitioners by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

It will be appreciated that before passing the order, all the persons, who are likely to be affected, are heard.
